

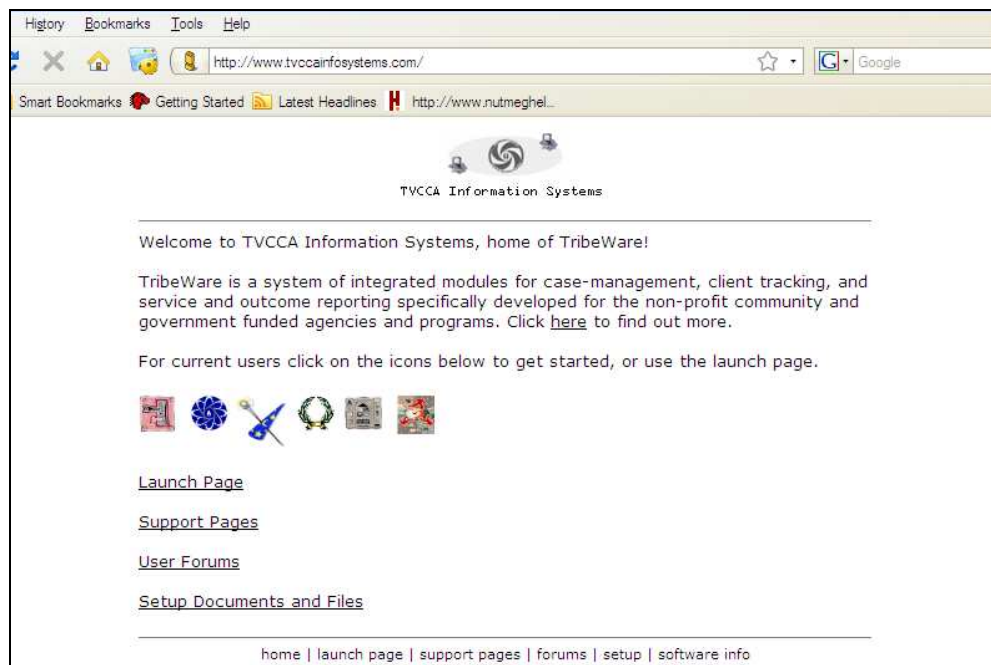
FORUMS

The main purpose of using forums is to have an electronic information exchange. Think of them as an **organized** community bulletin board that you may have in your local supermarket or church. The main purposes of the Tribeware forums are:

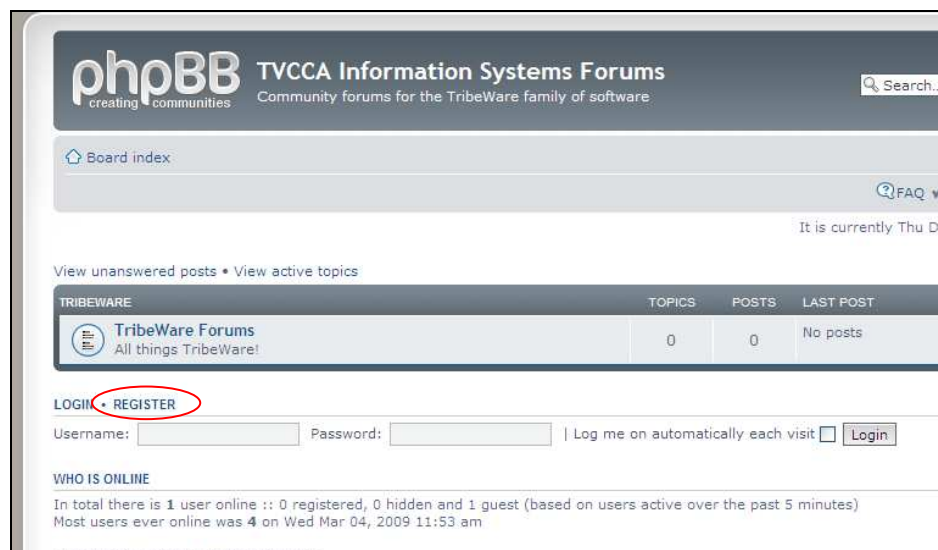
- Allow people to ask questions of their peers and brainstorm without having to be in the same physical location
- A place for IT staff to post Policies, Procedures, Best Practices

Getting to the FORUMS login page

- Go to 'http://www.tvccainfosystems.com'
- Click on the words "User Forums"



Creating YOUR Account (do this 1 time only)



Click the “REGISTER” button

- Read the “Terms of Service” and if you agree, click the “I agree to these terms”
- You will be taken to the “Registration Page”
 - Create a USERNAME
 - Enter your TVCCA Email address (twice)
 - Create a password (enter twice)
 - Enter the CONFIRMATION Code (on the bottom of the screen)
